Reading: A reading from Matthew 25: 31-46 Glory to you O Lord

When the Son of Man comes in his glory with all the angels, he will sit on the throne of glory. All the nations will be brought before him, and as a shepherd separates the sheep from the goats, so will he divide them, placing the sheep on his right and the goats on his left. The King will say to those on his right; "Come, blessed of my Father! Take possession of the kingdom prepared for you from the beginning of the world. For I was hungry and you fed me, I was thirsty and you have me to drink. I was a stranger and you welcome me into your house. I was naked and you clothed me. I was sick and you visited me. I was in prison and you came to see me."

The Word of the Lord **Thanks be to God** Reflection. This piece of scripture makes a distinction not only between those who have compassion and those who do not, but between those who are in a position to help, and those who are in need.

The 'least' (those who do not have much) live at the mercy of others, they can be pressured into particular behaviours due to their own circumstances. Their choices are severely limited ...
