This week's theme is Love one another.

John 13:34 is a verse from the Bible that ask us to love one another, be tolerant, patient and help one another. Jesus showed that he loved us and laid down his life for us. He asks us to live our lives for one another and in service to others. Jesus is always there for us. This can be difficult to grasp as we cannot physically see Him but his presence guards and guides us.

The Bible uses the phrase "one another" often, and it says a lot about caring for each other and living in community. Relationships benefit when we follow God's teachings for how we should treat the "one anothers" that God has placed within our lives

John 13:33-35

Jesus said, "My children, I am with you for only a little while; you will look for me, but as I have already told the Jews, so now I tell you, Where I am going you cannot come. A new commandment I give you, love one another, just as I have loved you, you also must love one another. By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another."



In the scripture reading, Jesus gives the commandment: "Love one another as I have loved you". Loving someone sounds easy but hardly ever done. We sometimes only accept the people who are genuinely good to us and disregard those who have done us wrong. But what Jesus is trying to say to us is to love everyone especially those who are unlovable.
